- Wireless Internet access in every room
- Open visiting hours

The Cancer Care program at Sunrise is accredited by the American College of Surgeons' Commission on Cancer and is recognized by the Commission on Cancer as a Community Hospital Comprehensive Cancer Program, the only such program in Las Vegas, which means our program meets stringent criteria for services and quality.
