Physicians may now view in-patient and outpatient images over a secure network from their office, clinic, imaging center, hospital, or even home.

The Picture Archiving and Communications System is a computer network dedicated to the storage, retrieval, and distribution of X-rays, sonograms, MRI's, CT scans and other diagnostic imagery. The web-based format, initiated in this market by Sunrise Health, allows physicians to access in-patient and outpatient images from virtually any location, including their home, private practice office, clinic, or hospital.

Stacy Acquista, communication specialist for Sunrise Hospital, points out that that “very little of a person’s healthcare is delivered inside the hospital walls, making it extremely important to be able to share images taken at our facilities with a patient’s primary care physician or specialist. Up until now, patients and/or physicians had to physically pick up X-rays from a hospital or outpatient imaging center, but with PACS, the images can be shared digitally and in a higher resolution for more precise diagnoses.”

“PACS is a revolutionary tool that benefits both the patient and the physician,” says Dr. Richard Schwartz of Red Rock Radiology. “For our patients, it means speedier diagnosis from a sub-specialty trained physician from anywhere in our network – which now spans most of Las Vegas – and for physicians, it means a more convenient way to treat their patients effectively.”
